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# COMMITTEE AMENDMENT

COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 68, L.D. 72

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#### SUMMARY

This amendment is the majority report. The amendment replaces the bill and changes its title. 6 It directs the Department of Environmental Protection to include in its biennial 8 climate change evaluation a review of the cost-effectiveness of the actions taken toward meeting the greenhouse gas emissions reduction goals. It also requires the department to submit a 10 report of its evaluation to the joint standing committee of the Legislature having jurisdiction over natural resources matters 12 and it authorizes the committee to report out legislation 14 relating to the evaluation to the second regular session of any Legislature.
