	A licensee may sell liquor to a person only if that person
ġ	isplays an unexpired and otherwise valid driver's license or a
S	tate identification card issued by any state of the United
S	tates or any of its territories or the District of Columbia
<u>S</u>	howing a photograph and signature.
	SUMMARY
t	This bill requires a person regardless of that person's age to present identification at the time of purchase of liquor.
