COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 84, L.D. 108

3. Report and recommendation. The department shall report to the joint standing committee of the Legislature having jurisdiction over health and human services matters and the joint standing committee of the Legislature having jurisdiction over the bill proposing the mandate on the results of the mandate review, including a recommendation from the department regarding the proposed mandate and options for changing the proposed mandate to address significant challenges identified in the mandate review.'

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### SUMMARY

This amendment is the minority report of the committee. The 16 amendment replaces the bill. It changes the proposed mandate review procedure to an option for the legislative committee of 18 jurisdiction. It narrows the proposed legislation that would be subject to mandate review to bills that would add administrative 20 costs through the MaineCare program to physicians and health care providers licensed by the Department of Health and Human 22 Services. It specifies that the review must include consideration of social and financial impacts and medical 24 efficacy.

Because the number of such requests cannot be determined in advance, the additional resources the department may require cannot be determined at this time. The Bureau of Insurance within the Department of Professional and Financial contracts for similar mandate reviews at a cost of \$12,000 per study.
