Resolved: That the Department of Transportation shall authorize the construction of a new entrance from Interstate 95 Exit 113 roadway to the planned Central Maine Medical Services Regional Cancer Treatment facility on Old Belgrade Road in Augusta. Authorization for construction of a new entrance is contingent upon commencement of construction of the facility.
