20	Current law prohibits smoking in the enclosed areas of
	restaurants and most other public places, but does not prohibit
22	smoking in bingo halls, off-track betting facilities and private
	clubs that are licensed for the sale of food and alcohol. This
24	bill prohibits smoking in the enclosed areas of all places
26	licensed for the sale of food and alcohol while those places are open for such purposes.
