Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

	4. Limitation. The assessment procedure required by this

	certification of eligibility for residents of nursing facilities
8	who have end-stage diseases or who are terminally ill by either
	the department or the federal Department of Health and Human
1.0	Services. If a federally required assessment of eligibility for
	services is completed to cover an eligibility period similar to
12	the state eligibility period, assessment under this section must
	be waived by the department.
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SUMMARY

18 This bill requires the Department of Health and Human Services to accept assessments of eligibility for nursing facility services completed for federal purposes for persons with 20 end-stage diseases and persons who are terminally ill.
