	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
	Sec. 1. 17-A MRSA §610 is enacted to read:
:	<u>§610. Illegal personal benefit</u>
	A person is guilty of illegal personal benefit if, being a
	public servant, that person derives personal benefit or gain from
	arranging or participating in a private business transaction that
	uses information derived from the public office in which that
	<u>person serves. Illegal personal benefit is a Class E crime.</u>
	SUMMARY
	This bill designates as a Class E crime the use of public office information for personal benefit by a public servant.
