2	Sec. 1. 5 MRSA §17057, sub-§3. ¶B. as enacted by PL 2003, c.
4	632, §1, is repealed.
6	Sec. 2. 5 MRSA §17057, sub-§3, ¶C is enacted to read:
8	C. This subsection does not apply to home contact information of a retirement system member or a benefit
10	recipient used only for membership recruitment purposes by a nonprofit or public organization established to provide
12	programs, services and representation to Maine public sector retirees.

16	SUMMARY
18	This bill allows the Maine State Retirement System to provide the names and addresses of retirees to nonprofit or
20	public organizations established to provide programs and services to Maine public sector retirees. This bill repeals the current
22	waiver provision in the current law.
