2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

4 **Sec. 1. 1 MRSA §148** is enacted to read:

6 **§148. Family Reunion Day**

8 In recognition of the value and importance of families, the  
10 State designates the Monday after the first full weekend of  
12 August as Family Reunion Day. The Governor shall annually issue  
14 a proclamation urging citizens, businesses and organizations to  
16 observe the day with appropriate celebration and activity.

14 **SUMMARY**

16 This bill designates the Monday after the first full weekend  
18 of August as Family Reunion Day.
