SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 169, L.D. 230, Bill, "An Act To Authorize the Public Advocate To Represent Consumers in Federal Regulation of Railroads"

Amend the amendment in section 2 in that part designated "~~S1711.~~" in subsection 6 in the 3rd line (page 3, line 24 in amendment) by striking out the following: "committee" and inserting in its place the following: 'committees'

Further amend the amendment in section 2 in that part designated "~~S1711.~~" in subsection 6 in the 4th line (page 3, line 25 in amendment) by inserting after the following: "matters" the following: 'and transportation matters'

Further amend the amendment in section 2 in that part designated "~~S1711.~~" in subsection 7 in the 7th line (page 3, line 46 in amendment) by striking out the following: "committee" and inserting in its place the following: 'committees'

Further amend the amendment in section 2 in that part designated "~~S1711.~~" in subsection 7 in the 8th line (page 3, line 47 in amendment) by striking out the following: "matters may" and inserting in its place the following: 'and transportation matters may jointly'

2 Further amend the amendment in section 4 in the 2nd line  
4 (page 4, line 25 in amendment) by striking out the following:  
"may" and inserting in its place the following: 'and the Joint  
Standing Committee on Transportation may jointly'

8 **SUMMARY**

10 This amendment provides that the Joint Standing Committee on  
12 Utilities and Energy and the Joint Standing Committee on  
Transportation may jointly report out legislation concerning  
14 railroad freight service to the Second Regular Session of the  
122nd Legislature. It also provides that the joint standing  
16 committee of the Legislature having jurisdiction over utilities  
and energy matters and the joint standing committee of the  
18 Legislature having jurisdiction over transportation matters may  
jointly report out legislation to the Second Regular Session of  
20 the 123rd Legislature concerning railroad service quality after  
reviewing a report submitted by the Public Advocate to both  
committees.
