### **An Act To Provide for Registration of Certain Snowmobile Trail-grooming Equipment**

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

4 **Sec. 1. 12 MRSA §13104-A** is enacted to read:

6 **§13104-A. Registration; trail-grooming equipment**

8 **1. Fee.** The registration fee for trail-grooming equipment is \$30.

10 **2. Eligibility.** Only entities that have approved contracts for snowmobile trail-grooming grants with the Department of Conservation, Bureau of Parks and Lands, Off-Road Vehicle Division are eligible for registration under this section.

14 **3. Term of registration.** Registration for trail-grooming equipment is valid from the date of issuance until the date that the equipment is sold or transferred.
