4	414, Pt. A, §2 and affected by c. 614, §9, is repealed and the
6	following enacted in its place:
U	25. Snowmobile. "Snowmobile" means a self-propelled
8	vehicle manufactured for off-road travel on snow that:
10	A. Has a curb weight of not more than 1,000 pounds;
12	B. Does not exceed 50 inches in width;
14	C. Is driven by a track or tracks in contact with the snow;

10	"Snowmobile" does not include a tracked vehicle engaged in a
20	trail-grooming activity on a statewide snowmobile trail system or
	public right-of-way that is open to snowmobiling.
