
HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 174, L.D. 235, Bill, "An Act To Increase the Minimum Wage"

Amend the amendment in subsection 1 in the first line (page 1, line 26 in amendment) by striking out the following: "The" and inserting in its place the following: 'The Except as provided in this subsection, the

Further amend the amendment in subsection 1 in the 6th, 7th and 8th lines (page 1, lines 31 to 33 in amendment) by striking out the following: "Starting October 1, 2006, the minimum hourly wage is \$6.75 per hour. Starting October 1, 2007, the minimum hourly wage is \$7.00 per hour." and inserting in its place the following: 'An employer with employees who work at least a total of 160 hours per week or with gross revenues of \$500,000 or more per year shall pay a minimum hourly wage of \$6.75 per hour starting October 1, 2006 and \$7.00 per hour starting October 1, 2007.'

SUMMARY

This amendment provides that the increase in minimum wage applies only to employers with employees who work at least a total of 160 hours per week or with gross revenues of \$500,000 or more per year.
