
HOUSE AMENDMENT "E" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 174, L.D. 235, Bill, "An Act To Increase the Minimum Wage"

Amend the amendment in subsection 1 in the 6th line (page 1, line 31 in amendment) by striking out the following: "2006" and inserting in its place the following: '2007'

Further amend the amendment in subsection 1 in the 7th and 8th lines (page 1, lines 32 and 33 in amendment) by striking out the following: "Starting October 1, 2007, the minimum hourly wage is \$7.00 per hour."

SUMMARY

This amendment delays the increase in the minimum wage to \$6.75 per hour to October 1, 2007 and eliminates the further increase proposed in Committee Amendment "A."
