
SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 174, L.D. 235, Bill, "An Act To Increase the Minimum Wage"

Amend the amendment in subsection 1 in the 7th line (page 1, line 32 in amendment) by inserting after the following: "hour" the following: 'for a person 18 years of age or older and \$6.50 per hour for a person who has not attained 18 years of age'

Further amend the amendment in subsection 1 in the 8th line (page 1, line 33 in amendment) by inserting after the following: "hour" the following: 'for a person 18 years of age or older and \$6.50 per hour for a person who has not attained 18 years of age'

SUMMARY

This amendment provides that the increases in the minimum wage apply only to a person 18 years of age or older.
