SENATE AMENDMENT "C" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 174, L.D. 235, Bill, "An Act To Increase the Minimum Wage"

Amend the amendment in subsection 1 in the 7th line (page 1, line 32 in amendment) by striking out the following: "\$6.75" and inserting in its place the following: '\$6.70'

Further amend the amendment in subsection 1 in the 8th line (page 1, line 33 in amendment) by striking out the following: "\$7.00 per hour." and inserting in its place the following: '\$6.85 per hour. Starting October 1, 2008, the minimum hourly wage is \$7.00 per hour.'

SUMMARY

This amendment increases the minimum wage to \$7.00 per hour over a 3-year period. Committee Amendment "A" increases the minimum wage to \$7.00 per hour over a 2-year period.
