Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

Sec. 1. Additional game warden for Sebago Lake region. The
4 Commissioner of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife shall appoint one
additional game warden to the Sebago Lake region. The new game
6 warden position must be funded from the Lake and River Protection
Fund established under the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 12,
8 section 10257.
