COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 194, L.D. 255, Bill, "An Act To Require a Person Operating Farm Equipment on Public Roads To Be Adequately Trained"

Amend the bill by striking out the title and substituting the following:

'Resolve, Directing the Bureau of Motor Vehicles To Examine the Feasibility of Implementing a Mandatory Training Course for a Person Operating a Farm Vehicle on a Public Road'

Further amend the bill by striking out everything after the title and before the summary and inserting in its place the following:

'Sec. 1. Mandatory farm vehicle training. Resolved: That the Department of the Secretary of State, Bureau of Motor Vehicles, in conjunction with the Department of Agriculture, Food and Rural Resources, the Department of Public Safety and the Maine Farm Bureau Association shall examine the feasibility of implementing a mandatory training course for the operation of farm vehicles on public roads, including, but not limited to, course curriculum, administration, location and cost. Upon completion of its review, the Bureau of Motor Vehicles shall submit its findings, including any necessary implementing legislation, to the Joint Standing Committee on Transportation no later than November 1, 2005.'
