	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

	Sec. 1. 26 MRSA §621-A, sub-§5 is enacted to read:

	5. Change in rate of pay. Payment of wages must be made at
6	the rate previously established, except that the employer may
	decrease the rate of pay if the employer gives advance notice to
8	all affected employees at least one pay period prior to the
	change. Changes of rates of pay made under a collective
10	bargaining agreement are exempt from this requirement.

	SUMMARY

	This bill requires an employer to notify employees at least
16	a pay period in advance of any decrease in pay. It also provides
	an exception for changes made under a collective bargaining

agreement.

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
