#### Fiscal Detail and Notes

This bill includes Other Special Revenue Funds allocations of \$55,043 and \$76,531 in fiscal years 2005-06 and 2006-07, respectively, for the establishment of one Manufactured Housing Inspector position and related all other expenses beginning October 1, 2005.

Sufficient funds are available within the budgeted resources of the Manufactured Housing Board to support the additional position through the 2006-2007 biennium.
