COMMITTEE AMENDMENT **A** to S.P. 88, L.D. 268, Bill, "An Act To Allow Electronic Calling Devices for Hunting"

Amend the bill by striking out the title and substituting the following:

'An Act To Allow Electronic Calling Devices for Hunting Moose'

Further amend the bill by striking out all of section 1.

Further amend the bill by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read consecutively.

SUMMARY

This amendment does not affect the provision of the bill that removes the prohibition against calling devices when moose hunting. This amendment removes section 1 of the bill, which would have specifically authorized electronic calling devices except when hunting migratory birds. Current law does not prohibit the use of such devices unless hunting moose or migratory game birds.
