#### 'An Act To Ensure Proper Registration of Voters on Election Day'

Further amend the bill by striking out everything after the enacting clause and before the summary and inserting in its place the following:

- 'Sec. 1. 21-A MRSA §122, sub-§4, as amended by PL 1995, c. 459, §14, is further amended to read:
- 34 Election day registration. The registrar shall accept registrations of applicants who appear in person on election day. The registrar shall issue to each of these applicants a 36 certificate entitling the applicant to be placed on the voting 38 list at the voting place. Only one certificate may be issued to a person. An applicant whose address has changed since the 40 applicant last voted must vote using the ballot or ballots for the new polling place, if applicable, on election day. If the 42 registrar requests that a person registering to vote on election day return to the voting place with further information to prove identity or residency and that person does not return that day 44 before the polls close, the registrar shall forward the name 46 given by that person to the appropriate district attorney for investigation of voter fraud.'

This amendment replaces the bill. It also changes the title of the bill. The amendment states that if a registrar of voters requests that a person registering to vote on election day return with information to prove identity or residency and that person does not return with that information, then that name is to be referred to the appropriate district attorney for investigation of voter fraud.
