22	Amend the bill in section 1 in that part designated
24	"§1318-A." by adding at the end a new paragraph to read:
26	'At the request of one or more municipalities, a county may bring legal action for recovery under this section on behalf of
28	the municipality or municipalities. If the county is successful in the action, the county is entitled to recover the cost of the
30	action and reasonable attorney's fees.'

34	SUMMARY
36	This amendment authorizes a county, at the request of one or more municipalities, to sue for recovery on their behalf for
38	removal costs associated with prohibited discharges of hazardous materials. It also provides for the recovery of legal costs and
40	attorney's fees associated with the legal action.
