	Current law provides a sales tax exemption for a clean fuel
16	vehicle, defined as a vehicle that may be propelled by a clean fuel or a fuel-cell electric vehicle that uses any fuel, but only
18	up to the amount that the clean fuel vehicle price exceeds the price of a gasoline-fueled or diesel-fueled internal combustion
20	vehicle.
22	This bill exempts from the sales tax 100% of the sale or lease price of a hybrid gasoline-electric vehicle or a fuel-cell
24	or hydrogen-fueled vehicle.
