	Emergency preamble. Whereas, acts of the Legislature do not
2	become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and

6	Whereas, continued safe, efficient and reliable rail service is essential to our State; and
8	Whereas, trains run by remote control are operating in parts of the United States; and
