COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 207, L.D. 282, Bill, "An Act To Prohibit a Registered Sex Offender from Residing within 1,000 Feet of the Residence of Any Child, a School, Day Care Center or Playground"

Amend the bill by striking out the title and substituting the following:

'An Act To Prohibit Sex Offenders Whose Victims Were Children Less Than 12 Years of Age from Residing or Establishing a Domicile within 500 Feet of an Elementary School'

Further amend the bill in section 1 by striking out all of subsection 6 and inserting in its place the following:

'6. Place of domicile or residence. A registrant who committed a sex offense or sexually violent offense against a child less than 12 years of age may not establish or maintain a domicile or reside within 500 feet of a public or private elementary school. For purposes of this subsection, "elementary school" has the same meaning as in Title 20-A, section 1.'

SUMMARY

This amendment is the minority report of the Joint Standing Committee on Criminal Justice and Public Safety. The amendment prohibits a registrant under the Sex Offender Registration and Notification Act of 1999 who committed a sex offense or sexually violent offense against a child less than 12 years of age from
