4 **Sec. 1. 20-A MRSA §13451, sub-§3, ¶¶B and C,** as amended by PL
2003, c. 451, Pt. 00, §1, are further amended to read:

6 B. Thirty-five percent from July 1, 2002 ~~to~~ until July 31,
2003; and

8 C. Forty percent ~~after~~ from July 31, 2003, to July 31,
10 2005; and

12 **Sec. 2. 20-A MRSA §13451, sub-§3, ¶D** is enacted to read:

14 D. Forty-five percent after July 31, 2005.

18 This bill increases the State's contribution for health
20 insurance for retired educators from 40% to 45% after July 31,
2005.
