## An Act To Improve Recreational Watercraft Safety

	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2	Sec. 1. 12 MRSA §10108. sub-§12 is enacted to read:
4	12 Decampl watercraft training and certificate program
6	12. Personal watercraft training and certificate program. The commissioner shall establish a program for training and certifying individuals 14 years of age and older in the safe
8	operation of personal watercraft. The commissioner may cooperate with any public or private association or organization having as
10	one of its objectives the promotion of safety in operating a watercraft.

14	In establishing the program under this subsection, the commissioner shall:
16	A. Prescribe the type of instruction and the requirements for the satisfactory completion of a personal watercraft
18	safety program using the criteria published by a nationwide organization of administrators of state boating laws;
20	B. Prescribe and promote the times and places of
22	instruction;
24	C. Issue a certificate of competency to individuals who successfully complete a personal watercraft safety program;

28	D. Adopt rules establishing the extent to which the certificate program will be used in the operation and registration of personal watercraft; and
30	E. Charge a fee of \$10 per person enrolled in the program.

34	The rules adopted pursuant to this subsection are routine technical rules as defined in Title 5, chapter 375, subchapter 2-A.
