

HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to HOUSE AMENDMENT "C" to H.P. 233, L.D. 309, Bill, "An Act To Remove the Sunset on Part-time Unemployment Insurance Benefits"

Amend the amendment in section 2 in subsection 1 in paragraph B in the last line (page 1, line 38 in amendment) by inserting after the following: "fund" the following: ', including, but not limited to, examining the minimum amount of work for which a worker collecting unemployment compensation benefits must search'
