COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 256, L.D. 333, Bill, "An Act Regarding the Sale of Firearms at Gun Shows"

Amend the bill in section 1 in that part designated "\$2043." by striking out all of subsection 4 (page 2, lines 22 to 24 in L.D.) and inserting in its place the following:

'4. Penalty. The following penalties apply to violations of this section.

A. A person who violates this section commits a civil violation for which a fine of not more than \$1,000 may be adjudged.

B. A person who violates this section after having been previously adjudicated as violating this section commits a civil violation for which a fine of not more than \$2,500 may be adjudged.

C. A person who violates this section after having been previously adjudicated as violating this section 2 or more times commits a civil violation for which a fine of not more than \$5,000 may be adjudged.'

SUMMARY

This amendment is the minority report of the Joint Standing Committee on Criminal Justice and Public Safety. The amendment replaces the penalty provision of the bill, which would have
