Sec. 1. 14 MRSA §6028, sub-§1, as enacted by PL 1987, c. 215,
is amended to read:

1. Late payment. A payment of rent is late if it is not
made within ~~15~~ 7 days from the time the payment is due.

This bill decreases from 15 to 7 the number of days that
must pass before a landlord may assess a penalty for the late
