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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

Sec. 1. 35-A MRSA §8903 is enacted to read:

§8903. Information number

A provider of mobile telecommunications services shall provide a service that allows a customer to learn, by calling a telephone number, the exact amount of calling minutes available to that customer in the current billing month under the customer's contract. The provider may not charge the customer for accessing or using this service.
