#### Fiscal Detail and Notes

Reflects the bill's requirement that child care facility licenses, nursery school licenses and home day care certificates be issued for a 2 year term. It is assumed General Fund undedicated revenue from these sources would double in the first year of each two-year term, and be eliminated in the second year of the term.
