## An Act To Change the Child Care Facility Licensing Laws

## Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows: 2 Sec. 1. 22 MRSA §7802, sub-§2, ¶B, as amended by PL 1999, c. 599, $\S1$ , is further amended to read: 4 6 в. The terms of full licenses or approvals are as follows. 8 Except as provided in subparagraphs $(2)_{r}$ -(-3)--and (1) (4) to (5), the term of all full licenses and approvals 10 issued pursuant to this chapter is for one year or the remaining period of a conditional or provisional 12 license that has been issued for less than one year. 14 (2) The term of a residential child care facility license is for 2 years. 16 (3) The term of a drug treatment center license may be for either one or 2 years. 18 20 The term of a family foster home or specialized (4) foster home license is for 2 years. 22 (5) The term of a child care facility as defined in 24 section 8301-A, subsection 1-A, paragraph B is for 2 years. 26 Sec. 2. 22 MRSA §8301-A, sub-§2, as amended by PL 2001, c. 645, $\S6$ , is further amended to read: 28 2. Child care facility licensure. The owner or operator of 30 a child care facility shall pay the licensing fee required under section 8303-A. A child care facility must be licensed under 32 this chapter and must comply with the rules adopted by the commissioner under section 8302-A and 34 the fire safety requirements of section 8304-A. The department shall make at least one unannounced inspection of a child care facility 36 licensed under this chapter during the term of the license. Except as otherwise provided, a nursery school must meet the 38 requirements of this chapter and chapter 1675. 40 Sec. 3. 22 MRSA §8303-A, as amended by PL 1997, c. 494, §12 and affected by 15, is further amended to read: 42 44 §8303-A. Fee for licenses By January 1, 1998, the department shall adopt rules to 46 establish reasonable fees for both initial licensure or

48 certification and license or certification renewals for day care centers, <u>child care facilities</u>, nursery schools and certified
50 home day care providers. Rules adopted pursuant to this section

are major substantive rules pursuant to Title 5, chapter 375, 2 subchapter II-A 2-A.

Sec. 4. Fee established. The fee the Department of Health and 4 Human Services establishes for a child care facility license issued under the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 22, section 7802, б must be twice the fee of the license issued on an annual basis. 8 **SUMMARY** 10 12 This bill requires that a license for a child care facility be issued for a 2-year term, that the Department of Health and Human Services make at least one unannounced inspection of a 14 child care facility within the 2-year license term and that the 16 fee for a 2-year child care facility license be \$160.
