CONCEPT DRAFT SUMMARY

This bill is a concept draft pursuant to Joint Rule 208.

The purpose of this bill is to recognize scallop spat 10 collection as a fishery and to direct the Scallop Advisory Council to develop rules to govern spat collection as a fishery. 12 Rules that would be needed include scale of collection, eligibility of people involved and whether spat can be viable as 14 a fishery. The bill would also direct the council to work with the Department of Marine Resources concerning the sale of whole 16 cultured scallops.
