2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

4 **Sec. 1. 23 MRSA §709** is enacted to read:

6 **§709. Application fee waived**

8 The Commissioner of Transportation shall waive the
10 application fee for a project if the anticipated project cost is
12 less than \$2,000,000.

14 **Sec. 2. 38 MRSA §352, sub-§7** is enacted to read:

16 **7. Processing fee waived.** The commissioner shall waive the
18 processing fee for a project under this section if the
20 anticipated project cost is less than \$2,000,000.

22 **SUMMARY**

This bill requires the Commissioner of Environmental Protection and the Commissioner of Transportation to waive the application or processing fee for projects with anticipated costs that are less than \$2,000,000.
