2	become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and

6	Whereas, the Baxter Compensation Authority was established to compensate students at the Governor Baxter School for the Deaf
8	who suffered physical or sexual abuse; and
10	Whereas, current funding for the Baxter Compensation Authority is insufficient to compensate all eligible victims; and
12	Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of
14	Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and
16	safety; now, therefore,
