	10. Lobbyist. "Lobbyist" means:
	A. A person who is specifically employed by another person
	for the purpose of and who engages in lobbying in excess of
	8 hours in any calendar month; or
	B. An individual who engages in lobbying in excess of 8
	hours in any calendar month, whether or not some or all of
	the hours spent lobbying are on a pro bono basis, and who is
	compensated by the individual's employer or by another
	entity for the time spent lobbying.
	"Lobbyist" does not include a lobbyist associate.
