18	COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 303, L.D. 418, Bill, "An
20	Act To Exempt Certain Tires from the Speed Rating Requirements"
22	Amend the bill by striking out everything after the title and before the summary and inserting in its place the following:
24	'Emergency preamble. Whereas, acts of the Legislature do not
26	become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and
28	Whereas, this Act corrects an unintended consequence of a
30	current law that requires a vehicle to be equipped with tires that meet or exceed the load and speed rating of the original
32	equipment tires; and
34	Whereas, it is necessary that this Act take effect before
36	the spring season, when many Maine citizens change the tires on their motor vehicles from snow tires to regular tires; and
38	Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts
40	create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as immediately
42	necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now, therefore,
44	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 303, L.D. 418

Sec. 1. 29-A MRSA \$1917, sub-\$2, as amended by PL 2003, c. 146, \$1, is further amended to read:

2. Safe tires required. A motor vehicle may not be operated on a public way unless it is equipped with tires in safe operating condition. A tire mounted on a motor vehicle is not considered to be in safe operating condition unless it meets the visual and tread depth requirements set forth in subsections 3 and 4 and the wheel size requirements in subsection 6. A-vehicle
may-be-equipped only with tires that meet or exceed the -load and speed-rating-of-the-eriginal-equipment-tires.

Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited in the 14 preamble, this Act takes effect when approved.'

SUMMARY

This amendment removes the requirement that a vehicle must 20 be equipped with tires that meet or exceed the load and speed rating of the original equipment tires. The amendment also adds 22 an emergency preamble and emergency clause to the bill.
