Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

Sec. 1. 12 MRSA §11404, sub-§1, ¶A, as enacted by PL 2003, c.
4 414, Pt. A, §2 and affected by c. 614, §9, is amended to read:

A. The commissioner shall establish by rule the length of
the special muzzle-loading season. The commissioner may
8 establish seasons of different lengths in different regions
of the State. The season may extend for no more than ~~12~~ 18
10 hunting days in any part of the State.
