2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

4 **Sec. 1. 12 MRSA §13155, sub-§2-A is enacted to read:**

6 2-A. Limited reciprocity. The commissioner may grant  
8 reciprocity up to 7 days to a nonresident ATV user from New  
10 Hampshire or the Canadian provinces of Quebec or New Brunswick to  
12 participate in a festival or special event in the State if the  
14 organizers of the festival or special event give the commissioner  
16 written notice 60 days prior to the festival or special event and  
18 provide the commissioner with a map of the trails to be used  
20 during the festival or special event.

### SUMMARY

16 This bill authorizes the Commissioner of Inland Fisheries  
18 and Wildlife to grant a conditional reciprocity to certain  
20 nonresident ATV users to participate in festivals and special  
events held in the State.
