Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

2
4 **Sec. 1. 12 MRSA 13155, sub-§11** is enacted to read:

6 11. Paraplegics. The commissioner may issue, upon
8 application, a complimentary ATV registration to a person who is
10 a paraplegic or a single or double amputee. The commissioner may
12 place restrictions on a registration issued under this
14 subsection. A registration issued under this subsection is valid
16 for one year unless suspended or revoked.

SUMMARY

14 This bill authorizes the Commissioner of Inland Fisheries
16 and Wildlife to issue a complimentary ATV registration to a
person who is a paraplegic or a single or double amputee.
