2	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2 4	Sec. 1. 22 MRSA §2150-C, sub-§1, as enacted by PL 2001, c. 364, §1, is amended to read:
6	1. Definitions. As used in this seetion chapter, unless
8	the context otherwise indicates, the following terms have the following meanings.
10	A. "Automated external defibrillator" or "AED" means a medical device approved by the United States Food and Drug
12	Administration that:
14	(1) Is capable of recognizing the presence or absence of of ventricular fibrillation or rapid ventricular
16	tachycardia;
18	(2) Is capable of determining whether defibrillation should be performed on an individual;
20	(3) Upon determination that defibrillation should be
22	performed, automatically charges and requests delivery of an electrical impulse to an individual's heart; and
24 26	(4) Upon action by an operator, delivers an appropriate electrical impulse to the individual's
28	heart to perform defibrillation.
30	B. "Department" means the Department of Public Safety.
32	Sec. 2. 22 MRSA §2150-D is enacted to read:
34	<u>§2150-D. Facilities for adults</u>
36	 Equipment. A nursing home licensed under section 1811 or a facility licensed for the care of adults under Subtitle 6, including a long-term care facility, residential care facility,
38	assisted housing program or assisted living program, must be equipped with an automated external defibrillator on each floor
40	of the facility.
42	2. Training. A staff member for a nursing home licensed under section 1811 or a facility licensed for the care of adults
44	under Subtitle 6, including a long-term care facility, residential care facility, assisted housing program or assisted
46	living program, must be certified to perform cardiopulmonary resuscitation and trained to operate an automated external
48	defibrillator.
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SUMMARY

This bill requires that nursing homes and other facilities for adults such as long-term care facilities, residential care facilities, assisted living programs and assisted housing programs be equipped with an automated external defibrillator on each floor of the facility. This bill also requires staff members of such facilities to be trained in CPR and in the operations of automated external defibrillators.

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
