IV, Part Second, §1" in section 1 in the last line (page 1, line 44 in L.D.) by inserting after the following: "divided" the following: 'except that, for the Legislature that convenes in 2007, 16 members hold their office 2 years from the 22 day next preceding the first Wednesday in December following the general election'

Further amend the resolution in that part relating to "Constitution, Art. IV, Part Second, §2, first ¶" in section 2 in the last line (page 2, line 20 in L.D.) by inserting after the following: "intact." the following: 'The Legislature that convenes in 2005 shall determine which of the members of the Senate of the Legislature that convenes in 2007 hold their office 2 years from the day next preceding the first Wednesday in 32 December following the general election.'

34 Further amend the resolution by striking out all of the question (page 2, lines 33 to 36 in L.D.) and inserting in its 36 place the following:

'"Do you favor amending the Constitution of Maine to reduce the size of the House of Representatives from 151 members to
99 members, to limit the size of the Senate from no more than 35 members to 33 members and to provide 4-year terms
for Legislators, effective in the year 2007?"'

## **SUMMARY**

This amendment provides 4-year terms for Legislators. The 48 terms are staggered so that in 2007, 1/2 of the members of the Legislature would serve 2-year terms and 1/2 of the members would
