#### Fiscal Detail and Notes

Assumes a General Fund appropriation of just over \$2.5 million will be required for FY 2006-07 for the state costs of expanding the number of workers with disabilities covered under the MaineCare program based on the following assumptions: approximately 600 additional working disabled will participate at an average total cost (state and federal) to the MaineCare program of \$1,028 per person per month, and that 16% of these additional participants will contribute \$12 per month toward the costs of their MaineCare benefits. Because the bill does not include an emergency preamble, the fiscal note assumes this expansion of eligibility will begin August 1, 2006.

Also assumes a General Fund appropriation of \$75,000 will be required for fiscal year 2006-07 for the state costs to be incurred by the Bureau of Family Independence in the Department of Health and Human Services to administer this change in MaineCare eligibility, including the establishment of 2 positions and the reprogramming costs for the Department's automated client eligibility system (ACES).
