<b>40</b> 42	This bill is the recommendation of the majority of the Committee to Study Compliance with Maine's Freedom of Access Laws.
42	This bill provides an exception to the definition of "public
44	record" in Maine's freedom of access laws for the personal contact information of public employees.
46	"Personal contact information" means a public employee's
48	home address, telephone number, fax number, cellular phone number and pager number.

"Public employee" means an employee of a governmental entity as that term is defined in the Maine Tort Claims Act. This includes all state, county and local governmental bodies as well as other public entities. Because elected officials are excepted from the definition of "public employee" for the purposes of this statute, their personal contact information is not confidential.
