Notwithstanding any other provision of law, of the state funds appropriated and allocated in Part A of this Act to the Department of Health and Human Services, Medical Care - Payments to Providers account, a minimum of \$111,391,728 is designated in fiscal year 2005-06 and \$120,345,372 in fiscal year 2006-07 for the state share of MaineCare prospective interim payments to hospitals. addition, of the state funds appropriated and allocated in Part A of this Act to the Department of Health and Human Services, Medical Care - Payments to Providers account, a minimum of \$17,000,000 in fiscal year 2005-06 and \$17,000,000 in fiscal year 2006-07 is designated for the state share of MaineCare interim and final settlement payments to hospitals.'
