### Fiscal Detail and Notes

This amendment will increase the General Fund cost of the bill by \$783,704 in fiscal year 2005-06 and \$831,704 in fiscal year 2006-07. Based on the estimated year-end balances, a balanced budget is maintained for the 2006-2007 biennium.
