Sec. QQQQ-1. Appropriations and allocations. The following appropriations and allocations are made.

Initiative: Restores funding that was deappropriated in Part B due to the primary enforcement of seat belt statutes.

This amendment will increase the General Fund cost of the bill by \$783,704 in fiscal year 2005-06 and \$831,704 in fiscal year 2006-07. Based on the estimated year-end balances, a balanced budget is maintained for the 2006-2007 biennium.
