
Amend the amendment by striking out all of Part O.

**SUMMARY**

This amendment removes the provisions that apply the 7% sales tax on lodging to the casual rental of living quarters for more than 14 days in a calendar year, including cottages, condominium units and vacation homes, beginning July 1, 2005.

### Fiscal Detail and Notes

This amendment will increase the General Fund cost of the bill by \$3,607,244 in fiscal year 2005-06 and \$4,249,761 in fiscal year 2006-07. Based on the estimated year-end balances, a balanced budget is not maintained for the 2006-2007 biennium.
